- Develop test plans and test cases based on requirements and design specifications. Execute test cases for new product enhancements and run regression tests
- Perform thorough testing in a timely manner to ensure quality products are delivered on schedule
- Work with the development team to analyze test results and track issues in the bug reporting system
- Identify, recommend, and implement changes to enhance the effectiveness of quality assurance strategies
- Design and maintain test environments
- Support POS integration department by assisting with procedural and hardware/software problems
- Perform hardware/software maintenance and troubleshooting for a variety of POS systems
- Coordinate with technical support for the development of new software enhancements and/or bug fixes for fielded products
- Create accurate and detailed documentation relating to test procedures and results; this requires the ability to collect, analyze, interpret, and summarize test data
- Generate POS interface specifications and other written specifications as needed; high attention to detail is critical
